Paid Internships for Immigrant Youth Professionals

Success Skills Centre is offering a limited number of paid internships for immigrant youth professionals aged 30 and under. Presently, we have a number of employers offering the following positions for qualified individuals:

- Accounting
- Land Surveying
- IT (coding, robotics, advanced AI)
- Admin/Marketing
- Pharmacist

Individuals may be eligible for paid internship if they:

- are permanent residents, or a protected persons as defined by the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act (those holding temporary Work Permits or awaiting Permanent Resident status are not eligible), and those immigrant youth who are now Canadian citizens
- are legally entitled to work in Canada
- are between 18 and 30 years of age at the start of employment
- have Canadian Language Benchmark Level 6+
- are unemployed or underemployed
- are from visible minority communities
- have a disability
- have worked in their home country in their trained profession and are interested in moving forward with their accreditation
- are willing to commit to the full duration of the internship and the additional training required after hours
- will not have another full-time job while employed with the program
- are presently a graduate of community or technical college, or university

Internships:

- 16-weeks
- full-time at 35 hours per week, with option by the employer to top up the minimum wage granted
